Given below is a list of supplies requested by teachers at each grade level for next year (08-09). Hopefully this information will enable you to take advantage of summer sales. Please keep in mind that as supplies are used during the year they will need to be replenished. **PLEASE LABEL ALL SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME**

\*8/1 – 8/3, All clothing and shoes under \$100, school supplies under \$20 are tax exempt.

### Kindergarten

- Large Backpack (NO ROLLING PACKS PLEASE)
- 1 box of family size tissues
- 1 pkg. of stickers
- 1 box of baby wipes
- 8 large glue sticks
- 1 pkg. of snack size ziplock bags
- 1 pkg. of thin magic markers (**girls only**)  
(preferably Crayola or Rose Art)
- 1 box of gallon size ziploc Freezer bags (**girls only**)
- 1 pkg. of colored pencils (**boys only**)  
(preferably Crayola or Rose Art)
- 1 box of quart size ziploc freezer bags (**boys only**)

### First Grade

- 4 plain pocket folders (plastic folders last longer)
- 24 #2 pencils – plain (wooden U.S.A.)
- 1 pair child-size scissors (sharp points)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 bottle of white school glue, not gel
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 school box (standard size)
- 1 box of snack, sandwich or gallon ziploc bags
- 2 black marble composition notebooks
- 2 pkgs. of stickers (no minis)

### Second Grade

- 2 boxes (20 or 24) #2 pencils (for classroom use)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of 24 crayons or colored pencils
- 2 black & white composition notebooks
- 4 boxes of tissues (for classroom use)
- 1 bottle of glue
- 5 pocket folders for papers (must have pockets)
- 1 cm./in. ruler
- 1 pkg. of white board dry-erase markers
- 1 pkg. of 4 X 6 index cards
- boys-1 box of **gallon** ziploc bags
- girls-1 box of **sandwich** ziploc bags
- \*NO TRAPPER KEEPERS**
- \*NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**
- \*NO ROLLING BACKPACKS PLEASE**

### Third Grade

- 1 pkg. of glue sticks
- 1 pkg. of notebook paper (wide ruled)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 3 2-pocket folders with brad clips
- recorder (available for purchase at school)
- 1 1” binder with front pocket
- 1 pack dividers
- 1 box dry-erase markers
- 3 packs of ruled 3X5 index cards (white only)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 box of sandwich size ziploc bags
- Boys – 1 box of gallon-size ziploc bags
- Girls – 1 box of quart-size ziploc bags

### Fourth Grade

- 2 boxes of 24 pencils
- scissors (sharp, upper grade, good cutting)
- colored pencils
- ruler (with standard & metric marking)
- 1 pkg. of notebook paper (wide rule)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 colored pens
- 1 highlighter pen (yellow)
- pencil bag (no boxes)
- 1 pack of ruled 3X5 index cards
- 1 pack of post it notes
- 1 box of **dry-erase** markers (preferably Expo brand)
- 2 single subject spiral notebooks (wide rule)
- 6 2-pocket folders (2 pockets **with prongs** – 1 each red, blue, green, yellow, purple & orange)
- recorder (available for purchase at school)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 pkg of disinfecting wipes
- Boys – 1 box gallon-size ziploc bags
- Girls – 1 box sandwich size ziploc bags
- \*3-RING NOTEBOOKS ARE NOT NEEDED**

2 (2-pocket) folders with prongs in any color
